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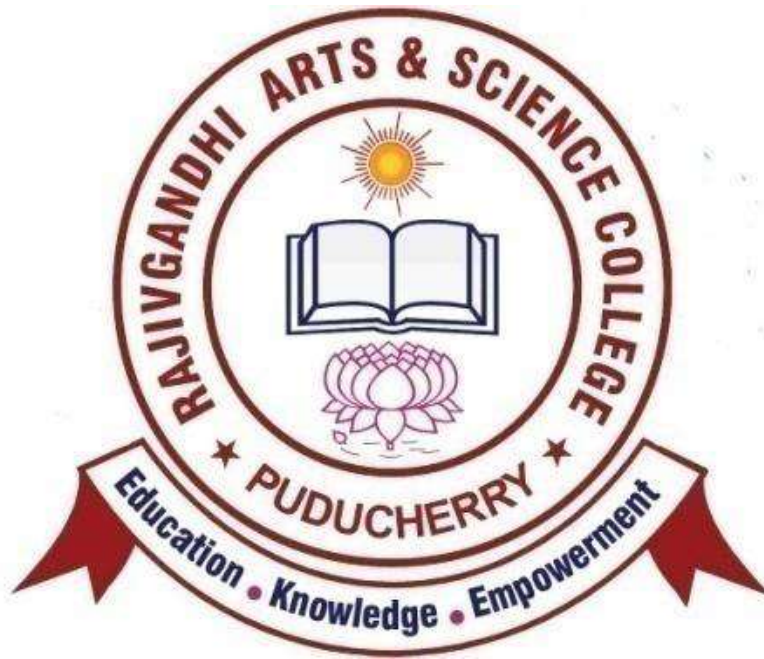

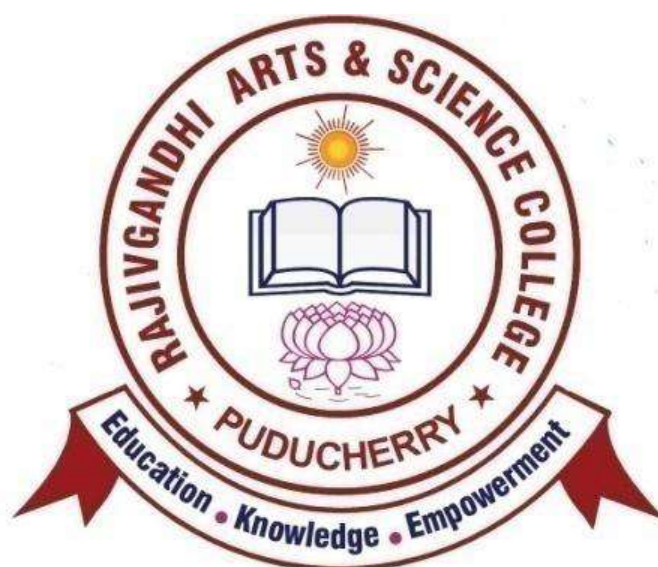

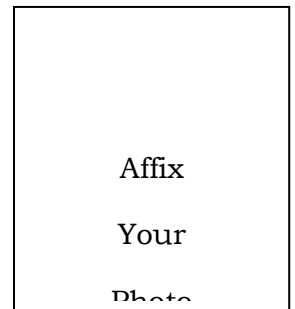

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INTRODUCTION

PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE

Rajiv Gandhi Arts and Science College, located in Thavalakuppam, Puducherry, plays a crucial role in providing higher education to rural students. Originally established in 1995 as an annexe of Tagore Arts College, which was founded by then Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru, the institution became independent and was renamed Rajiv Gandhi Arts and Science College. In March 2007, following the amalgamation of UTPASTICS with the Union Territory of Pondicherry Colleges of Education Society, the college became part of the newly formed Pondicherry Society for Higher Education (PONSHE). Registered under the Society Act 1860, it received approval from the Lt. Governor of Puducherry to function under its current name.

Affiliated with Pondicherry University, the institution offers five undergraduate programs in Arts and Science disciplines. Initially, from 1995, the college offered two undergraduate courses: B.Com. (General) and B.Com. (Co-operative Management), each with an intake of 30 students. By 2010, the college expanded its offerings to include Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A.), Bachelor of Computer Science (B.Sc. Computer Science), and Bachelor of Computer Applications (B.C.A.), each with an intake of 30 students. Currently, all departments have an intake capacity of 60 students, accommodating a total of 900 students through the centralized admission process managed by CENTAC.

In a significant development, the college introduced the National Education Policy (NEP) curriculum starting from the academic year 2023. This new curriculum aims to enhance educational quality and flexibility, aligning with the NEP's focus on holistic, multidisciplinary learning and competency-based education.

The college is situated on a spacious five-acre campus in a rural area, which provides convenient access for local students. The college is not only focused on academic excellence but also on holistic student development. The Career Guidance and Counselling Cell plays a crucial role in preparing students for the job market, offering advice, resources, and support to help them secure employment. Additionally, the college has invested in infrastructure to support physical and extracurricular development. An indoor stadium provides a venue for various sports and activities, while a 400-meter athletic track enhances opportunities for athletic training and events.

Beyond academics and infrastructure, Rajiv Gandhi Arts and Science College actively engages in several central schemes aimed at community development and environmental sustainability. The college participates in **Swachh Bharat Mission**, focusing on cleanliness and sanitation both on campus and in the surrounding community. It is also involved in the **Viksit Bharat Mission**, which aims to promote holistic development and progress in rural areas. Additionally, the college supports **Mission LiFE (Lifestyle for Environment)**, which encourages sustainable and eco-friendly practices to combat climate change and environmental degradation.

Extracurricular activities are encouraged through programs like N.C.C. (National Cadet Corps), N.S.S. (National Service Scheme), Village Adoption program and R.R.C. (Red Ribbon Club), all aimed at fostering leadership, community service, and personal growth.

The administration of the college is overseen by the Secretary to the Government (Education), who serves as the Chairman of the Society Colleges run by the Government of Puducherry. The Director of the Directorate of Higher & Technical Education acts as Member Secretary, contributing to the overall functioning of PONSHE, while the Principal manages the college's day-to-day operations. The institution's vision and mission reflect a commitment to providing comprehensive education and contributing to the socio-economic development of the rural community, adhering to the principle of "Education for All."

COURSE CURRICULUM

National Education Policy (NEP)

The Government of India has introduced the National Education Policy (NEP - 2020), to improve educational quality and flexibility, with an emphasis on holistic, multidisciplinary learning and competency-based education. This would bring significant reforms to the delivery and governance of higher education in the country. Pondicherry University has adopted the NEP and its Curriculum Framework from the Academic Year 2023-24 for both its campus and affiliated colleges.

In line with this, the college implemented the NEP curriculum for first-year students starting in the academic year 2023. However, for the 2023 batch, it would be a three-year program with NO multiple entry and exit options, whereas the NEP generally provides for a four-year program. For students in earlier batches, the college continues to use the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS).

Details about the NEP syllabus and other structural aspects are available on the Pondicherry University website. Students are encouraged to visit the site for additional information. NEP regulations will be applicable to affiliated colleges starting from the Academic Year 2023-24.

Major Highlights of NEP

- Multiple-Entry-Exit options. Exiting students at the end of First Year will be award a Certificate, second year end with a Diploma, third year end with a UG degree and 4th year end with an Honours Degree.
- Summer vacation is allocated for conducting Internships/fieldstudies/exploring/ScientificInnovations/conducting social/community outreach programmes and other similar field/work related programmes.

- Boards of Studies with inputs from different Colleges would design curriculum as per the NEP guidelines.
- Skill development courses for students in collaboration with industry partners. All Colleges are expected to network with skill development centres, vocational training institutes for facilitating student internships.
- Overall monitoring and implementation of NEP will be coordinated by college level NEP coordinating Committee and IQAC.
- NEP 2020 introduces the facility to breakdown the Programme of study at Undergraduate(UG) level after completion of every year of study. The students will be awarded the following:
 - An UG Certificate after completion of 1 Year (2 Semesters) of study in the chosen field of study.(After completing specific number of courses and 4 week internship)
 - An UG Diploma after completing 2 years (4 Semesters) of Study and an Internship.
 - A Bachelor Degree after completing 3 Years (6 Semesters) of Programme of Study.
 - A 4 year Bachelor Degree with Honors after completion of 8 Semesters (4 Years) of Programme of Study and a Research Project in final semester).

COLLEGE CODE OF CONDUCT

I. REGULAR ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

1. The college hours from 10 AM to 4 PM must be adhered to strictly. Students are required to be in the classroom by 9:55 AM for the morning session and by 1:25 PM for the afternoon session. Failure to do so will result in being marked absent for half a day.
2. Wearing ID card is a must inside the College Campus.
3. Students are instructed to come to college regularly and should not take leave unnecessarily. Students with less than 75% attendance in any course shall not be permitted to attend the end-semester university examination. Such student shall repeat the course when offered next.
4. Absence without leave letters will be viewed seriously. Prior permissions must be taken for availing leave. For availing leave upto 2 days, leave letter should be submitted on the previous day itself or on the day of return. For availing leave for more than 3 days for reason such as medical treatment, medical documents should be enclosed with the leave letter along with the parent's signature. If leave is taken without permission student should bring the parent on the day of return.
5. Students wishing to represent the college in inter-collegiate programs, seminars, conferences, workshops, skill development activities, or sports events must obtain proper permission from the department or college office. Failure to do so will result in the absence being recorded as leave,

and no official duty (OD) will be granted. NSS and NCC students also must obtain prior permission from their PO, CTO/ANO and inform their respective departments before participating in any activities or camps.

6. ID cards will be issued at the college office during the first year. If a student loses or damages their ID card, they must submit a letter counter signed by the Head of Department along with a fine of Rs. 30 to the college office to obtain a replacement. If the ID card is lost along with tag, then fine is Rs.100.
7. In case of any misbehavior or violation of the college rules, ID cards of the students will be with the Disciplinary committee faculty members till the enquiry is over.

II.DRESS CODE FOR BOYS AND GIRLS

All students on campus are required to always dress neatly and formally, including during examinations. For boys, formal attire consisting of a shirt and pants, with hair neatly cut and beard trimmed and groomed, is expected. However, if a student is growing a beard or hair for pilgrimage purposes, they must obtain prior permission from the department. For girls, wearing a chudidhar with a shawl pinned on both sides is recommended.

Dress Code for Boys – Don'ts

1. No Torn Jeans
2. No un-collared T-Shirts
3. No 3/4th / ankle folded pants
4. No long hair or beard.
5. No Punk/ Box hairstyles
6. No lines in Eyebrows
7. No earrings/studs/magnets/bangle/big chains etc

Dress Code for Girls - Don'ts

1. No full frock without shawl and pant
2. No jeans and T-shirts
3. No Sleeveless/Net sleeve tops/Chudidhar/dress
4. No short tops. Tops should be below knee length
5. No tight leggings/stretch pants

III. GENERAL CODE OF CONDUCT

Do's

1. Respect others: Treat fellow students, faculty, and non-teaching staff with respect and courtesy. Honor your parents
2. Follow College Rules: Must follow the college rules and regulations such as dress code, behaviour, Examination, attendance, and academic integrity.
3. Use resources responsibly: Utilize library resources, computer labs, and other facilities responsibly and as intended.

4. **Seek Knowledge:** Effectively use intellectual resources on campus, collaborate to expand your understanding, and develop your skills. Participate in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.
5. **Seek help when needed:** Seek assistance from HoDs, Class teachers, mentors, or counsellors when needed academically and if needed personally.
6. **Sanitation and hygiene:** Maintain personal hygiene to ensure a healthy environment for all. Student's Toilets should be used with care. Fine will be levied on breakage of doors/toilet fitting etc
7. **Green campus environment:** Switch off fans and lights when not in use. Conserve electricity, water. Grow plants and trees. Join hands for maintaining green environment.
8. **Safety regulations:** Follow safety guidelines and procedures in the college campus, especially in laboratories.
9. **Physical fitness:** Do moderate, vigorous physical exercise regularly. Practice healthy and nutritious food habits.
10. **Engage in volunteer activities:** Participate in activities such as NSS, NCC, the Red Ribbon Club, Village Adoption Program, Mission Life, Swachh Bharat (Clean India) and Vikshit Bharat (Developed India) and similar activities to contribute to the growth of peers and society. These initiatives offer valuable opportunities to engage in community service, support social causes, and develop leadership skills.

Don'ts

1. **Damage Property:** Do not scribble or write on doors or tables/desk which could deface the college and destroy the academic ambience. Do not damage college property, including buildings, toilet fittings, electrical fittings, furniture, computers and other equipment.
2. **Substance Abuse:** Smoking, drugs, alcohol or any other substance use are strictly prohibited on campus.
3. **Plagiarize or Cheat:** Avoid academic dishonesty in any form, including plagiarism and cheating during examinations.
4. **Disrupt Classes:** Refrain from disrupting lectures or other academic activities. Do not roam in the campus during college hours
5. **Misusing Facilities:** Do not misuse college facilities or equipment for unauthorized purposes. Refrain from bringing students from other colleges onto our campus. Disciplinary action will be enforced for violations.
6. **Noise Pollution:** Whistling, Howling, Bike honking, Silencer sound and engine revving up sound in motor vehicle are strictly prohibited.
7. **Use of Mobile Phone:** Restrict your mobile phone use in campus. Mobile phones should be switched off during class hours, in Library and quiet areas.
8. **Breach of Privacy:** Don't take photo/video of others without permission. Posting of such images/videos or misconduct on social media is strictly prohibited.

9. Littering on Campus: Avoid throwing used plastic covers, chocolate wrappers, pet bottles, cans and papers. Help in keeping your campus clean and neat.
10. Prohibited Expressions: Ragging or anti-institutional, anti-national, anti-social, anti-communal or immoral activities or political expressions or activities within the college campus is strictly prohibited.

IV. EXAMINATION RULES

PU Exam Rules

1. Students should not enter the Exam Hall without proper college dress code & ID Card.
2. Students should occupy the allotted seats at least 10 minutes before the commencement of all the examinations. Silence should be maintained in the examination hall.
3. Students themselves should check the Hall tickets, ID cards and calculators before entering the Exam Hall.
4. Mobile Phones, wallets, pouches, Bluetooth devices, smart watches and other belongings should be kept outside the exam hall only.
5. Candidates are prohibited from bringing any written or printed materials into the examination hall. Possession of notes, bits, study material, or any similar items will be deemed as malpractice.
6. Students are not allowed to exchange pencil, eraser, scale etc. inside the exam hall.
7. Students should write only their Register number on the question paper and they should not write anything else. Students should verify the subject code and subject name with hall ticket as soon as they receive the question paper. If there is any discrepancy, they should report it to the invigilator immediately.
8. Students writing regular exams should not leave the exam hall for any reason before 12.00 pm (Forenoon session) / 4 pm (Afternoon session) i.e. they should write for atleast 2 hours and they should leave the corridor immediately after coming out of the exam halls.

Malpractice

9. If a student is caught engaging in malpractice, it will be reported to the university immediately. The college will also initiate disciplinary action against the student. The student's parent will be notified right away, and the student's ID card and hall ticket will be withheld until the disciplinary committee completes its inquiry.

Internal Assessment Exam Rules

11. Two internal tests and model exam will be conducted for each subject. Students are expected to take these tests seriously and attend them. Each subject will have a total of 25 internal marks, with 20 marks allocated based on the internal assessment exam scores and the

LIBRARY FACILITY
