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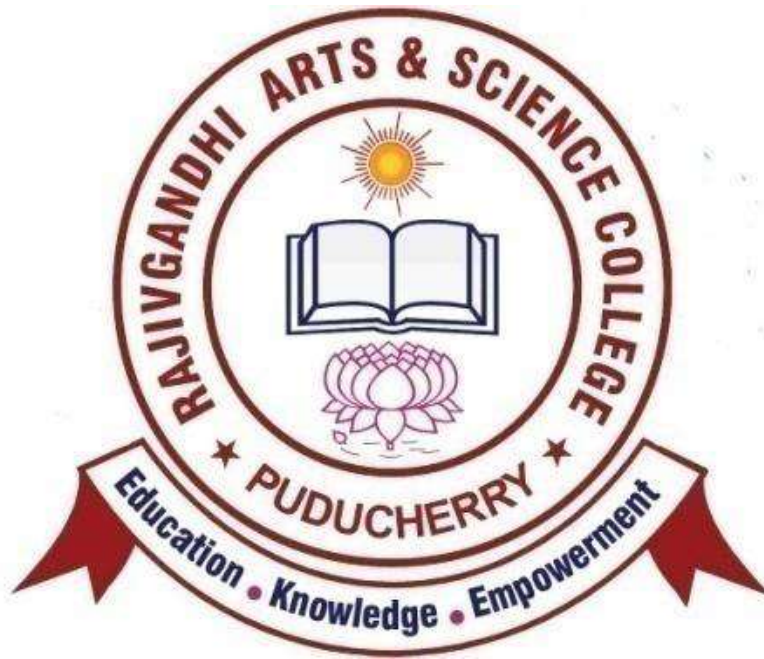

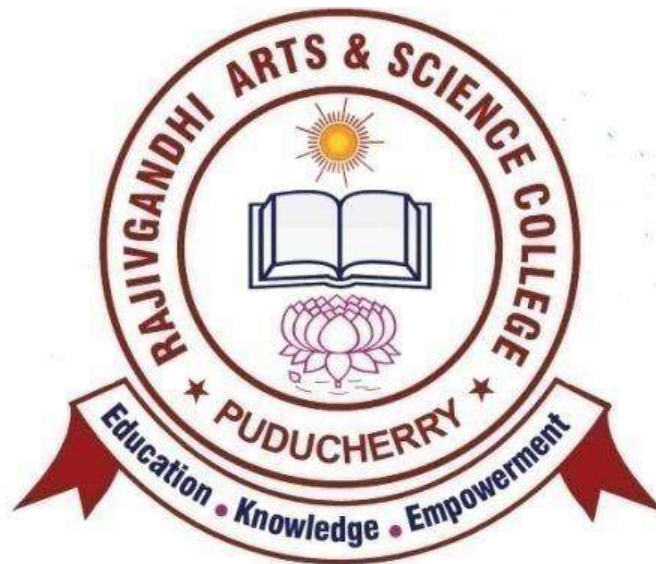

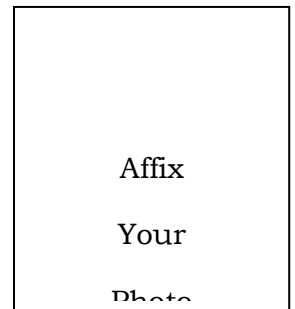

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INTRODUCTION

PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE

Rajiv Gandhi Arts and Science College, located in Thavalakuppam, Puducherry, plays a crucial role in providing higher education to rural students. Originally established in 1995 as an annexe of Tagore Arts College, which was founded by then Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru, the institution became independent and was renamed Rajiv Gandhi Arts and Science College. In March 2007, following the amalgamation of UTPASTICS with the Union Territory of Pondicherry Colleges of Education Society, the college became part of the newly formed Pondicherry Society for Higher Education (PONSHE). Registered under the Society Act 1860, it received approval from the Lt. Governor of Puducherry to function under its current name.

Affiliated with Pondicherry University, the institution offers five undergraduate programs in Arts and Science disciplines. Initially from 1995, the college offered two undergraduate courses: B.Com. (General) and B.Com. (Co-operative Management), each with an intake of 30 students. By 2010, the college expanded its offerings to include Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A.), Bachelor of Computer Science (B.Sc. Computer Science), and Bachelor of Computer Applications (B.C.A.), each with an intake of 30 students. Currently, all departments have an intake capacity of 60 students, accommodating a total of 900 students through the centralized admission process managed by CENTAC.

In a significant development, the college introduced the National Education Policy (NEP) curriculum starting from the academic year 2023. This new curriculum aims to enhance educational quality and flexibility, aligning with the NEP's focus on holistic, multidisciplinary learning and competency-based education.

The college is situated on a spacious five-acre campus in a rural area, which provides convenient access for local students. The college is not only focused on academic excellence but also on holistic student development. The Career Guidance and Counselling Cell plays a crucial role in preparing students for the job market, offering advice, resources, and support to help them secure employment. Additionally, the college has invested in infrastructure to support physical and extracurricular development. An indoor stadium provides a venue for various sports and activities, while a 400-meter athletic track enhances opportunities for athletic training and events.

Beyond academics and infrastructure, Rajiv Gandhi Arts and Science College actively engages in several central schemes aimed at community development and environmental sustainability. The college participates in **Swachh Bharat Mission**, focusing on cleanliness and sanitation both on campus and in the surrounding community. It is also involved in the **Viksit Bharat Mission**, which aims to promote holistic development and progress in rural areas. Additionally, the college supports **Mission LiFE (Lifestyle for Environment)**, which encourages sustainable and eco-friendly practices to combat climate change and environmental degradation.

Extracurricular activities are encouraged through programs like N.C.C. (National Cadet Corps), N.S.S. (National Service Scheme), Village Adoption program and R.R.C. (Red Ribbon Club), all aimed at fostering leadership, community service, and personal growth.

The administration of the college is overseen by the Secretary to the Government (Education), who serves as the Chairman of the Society Colleges run by the Government of Puducherry. The Director of the Directorate of Higher & Technical Education acts as Member Secretary, contributing to the overall functioning of PONSHE, while the Principal manages the college's day-to-day operations. The institution's vision and mission reflect a commitment to providing comprehensive education and contributing to the socio-economic development of the rural community, adhering to the principle of "Education for All."

COURSE CURRICULUM

National Education Policy (NEP)

The Government of India has introduced the National Education Policy (NEP - 2020), to improve educational quality and flexibility, with an emphasis on holistic, multidisciplinary learning and competency-based education. This would bring significant reforms to the delivery and governance of higher education in the country. Pondicherry University has adopted the NEP and its Curriculum Framework from the Academic Year 2023-24 for both its campus and affiliated colleges.

In line with this, the college implemented the NEP curriculum for first-year students starting in the academic year 2023. However, for the 2023 batch, it would be a three-year program with NO multiple entry and exit options, whereas the NEP generally provides for a four-year program. For students in earlier batches, the college continues to use the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS).

Details about the NEP syllabus and other structural aspects are available on the Pondicherry University website. Students are encouraged to visit the site for additional information. NEP regulations will be applicable to affiliated colleges starting from the Academic Year 2023-24.

Major Highlights of NEP

- Multiple-Entry-Exit options. Exiting students at the end of First Year will be award a Certificate, second year end with a Diploma, third year end with a UG degree and 4th year end with an Honours Degree.
- Summer vacation is allocated for conducting Internships/fieldstudies/exploring/ScientificInnovations/conducting social/community outreach programmes and other similar field/work related programmes.

- Boards of Studies with inputs from different Colleges would design curriculum as per the NEP guidelines.
- Skill development courses for students in collaboration with industry partners. All Colleges are expected to network with skill development centres, vocational training institutes for facilitating student internships.
- Overall monitoring and implementation of NEP will be coordinated by college level NEP coordinating Committee.

CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOUR

1. All the students must attend the College decently dressed. Tight garments such as Jeans, T shirts etc., must be avoided.
2. The possession of ID card in the college premises at all times is must.
3. At the first bell, announcing the commencement of the session (9.55 a.m. and 01.25 p.m.) students should be seated in their respective seats.
4. Every student must obey the teacher and respectfully carry out their instructions. The students shall observe politeness towards the non-teaching staff of the College and behave decorously with his / her fellow students.
5. No student shall leave the classroom or laboratory without the teacher's permission. Students must observe strict silence in the classes and listen to the lectures attentively, without distracting the attention of others.
6. Students must move to their classrooms or laboratories at the appointed hours silently. They must also remain silent during the interval between the teacher finishing his/her class and leaving and the next teacher entering to engage the class.
7. Students are forbidden from talking and making any sort of noise in the form of small or large group in the corridors or vicinity of rooms where classes are in progress or otherwise disturb them in any manner.
8. Every student must care for every property of the College and refrain from indulging in any activity that may damage the College property. Every student to whom books or any College property are entrusted will be held responsible for their preservation in good condition and in the event of their loss they will be required to replace them or repay their cost. Any student indulging in breaking or damaging any College property will be required to pay the cost of repair or replacements. In case of willful damage he / she will be punished in such a manner, as the Director may think fit.
9. Students should not leave the college during the working hours. Those who feel sick must contact the Head of the Department.

10. Students are prohibited from organizing any meeting or entertainment in the college or collecting money for any purpose without the permission of the Principal.
11. Students guilty of going over to other colleges and institutions to take part in acts of indiscipline such as organizing distortions and strikes would be deemed especially culpable and would be punished accordingly.
12. Students shall not hold meetings for criticizing the conduct of the University or the college authorities. Such meetings will be deemed unlawful and the Director will take such action as he / she deems necessary to prohibit or to punish and in case she considers it very serious he / she may recommend for rustication.
13. Teasing, ragging etc. are punishable offences to the extent of summary expulsion from the College.
14. Consumption of alcohol and other intoxicants or narcotics in any form in the campus is strictly prohibited. Smoking inside the college premises is banned and strictly prohibited.
15. The possession of weapons is strictly prohibited.
16. The use of Cell phones is strictly prohibited inside the campus. If found, the instrument will be seized immediately.
17. Students are expected to read the notice / circulars put up on the notice board regularly.
18. No notice, which does not have the approval of the Principal, shall be circulated or displayed in the Notice board.

RULES OF DISCIPLINE

1. The Principal of the College shall have complete power for the maintenance of the discipline of the students of the College. He / She may frame and issue, from time to time, disciplinary rules of a temporary or permanent character, regulating the conduct of the students within the campus or outside the College.
2. The Principal shall have the power to inflict punishment including fine, loss of attendance, withhold of term certificates, suspension, expulsion and rustication.
3. The Principal will ordinarily place himself / herself in communication where necessary, with the parent / guardian of the students who are academically backward and who do not show any improvement and whose attendance is irregular and whose conduct is unsatisfactory. The name of the students who are found incorrigible even after several warnings may be removed from the rolls after intimation to their parents / guardians. The order of the Principal in this matter shall be final.
4. The students of the college going on strike, in any way indulge in acts of indiscipline that may lead to dislocation of work in the college shall immediately forfeit their scholarships, fee concessions etc., besides punishments awarded by the Principal.

5. Petitions or complaints from individuals or groups to any higher authorities must be submitted only through the Principal.

DISCIPLINARY MEASURES

Disciplinary actions may include:

1. A reprimand or warning
2. To call the parent and take an undertaking from them.
3. Depending upon the gravity of the offence, appropriate action will be taken by the Disciplinary Committee headed by the Principal.
4. If he/she involves in misconduct such as second attempt indulging in malpractice in a university examination, gross misbehavior with teachers or disobeying the Principal and incidence of teasing, ragging which may not involve physical harm. When the behavior of the student vitiates the atmosphere of the College, suspension may be issued and the admission will be revived only after due consideration by Disciplinary Committee, paying Rs. 1000/- as revival fee
5. When a student indulges in breaking or damaging College property or other student's/teacher's property, fine will be imposed accordingly to the damage caused.
6. When a student is continuously absent for more than 7 working days without applying leave of absence to the appropriate authority and comes with a plea and wishes to rejoin after getting dropped. For such instances Rs. 100/- is to be paid as revival fee.
7. Suspension or issue of Transfer Certificate (TC)

LIBRARY FACILITY

1. The library is open on all working days from 9.00 a.m. to 5.30 p.m.
2. Library cards issued to students are not transferable.
3. The students shall be responsible for the book borrowed on his/her card.
4. Marking, underlining, annotating anywhere in the book are strictly forbidden.
5. Each student can borrow not more than two books at a time. The books must be returned or renewed within two weeks' time.
6. A student failing to return the books after two weeks from the date of issue will be fined Rs.1 per book per working day from the third week onwards.
7. Readers/ borrowers shall be responsible for any damage of books or other properties of the library and shall be required to replace the books or properties at their own cost. In case replacement is not possible, cost of the books or other property lost, damaged or injured is payable by the reader as follows:i) Double the current value of the book/property.
8. The Librarian reserves the right to recall the book at any time.
9. Students shall not carry any book or printed matter into the library.
10. Strict silence should be observed in the library. No discussion is allowed in the library.
